BOOK EXCERPT

Fear is a real and legitimate emotion, but when the government uses it to its own advantage to protect and grow its power, society falls into what the famous essayist Montesquieu described as despotism, where the government wields absolute power over its citizens. This is exactly what the Founding Fathers were dealing with in the case of King George III. Fear paralyzes. Fear neutralizes. Fear is perhaps the most powerful weapon used by tyrannical governments to silence and control the masses.

In his book, *The Spirit of the Laws*, Montesquieu detailed how a spirit of fear must be present for despotism to survive and thrive.⁸⁰ If a despot or dictator fears the people, his tyrannical powers are limited, but if he succeeds in getting the people to fear his power, he can force them to do as he wishes.

Conversely, liberty motivates. Liberty inspires the passion and commitment we need to live in freedom as defined in the Declaration of Independence and protected by the Constitution. Liberty and fear aren't necessarily mutually exclusive, but they can't coexist equally. We either surrender to fear and allow tyranny to rule, or we embrace liberty and the Constitution regardless of the consequences.

Throughout history, liberty in America has been under assault by despots and tyrants, but the assaults intensified after the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001. At that time, George W. Bush and a nearly unanimous Congress used the fear of terrorism to bring us the PATRIOT Act and other liberty-killing laws.

This assault on liberty gained new power during the so-called COVID-19 pandemic of 2020-2022, where the government used fear of the virus to launch an unprecedented assault on liberty. Mixing the fear-mongering of COVID-19 with the growing acceptance of socialist and Marxist ideology, liberty-killing policies were passed or proposed by both Republicans and Democrats, not letting the COVID-19 "crisis" go to waste, thus allowing them to do things they were unable to do before.

Over time, Nationalist Republicans—they incorrectly refer to themselves as conservatives—have come to believe many of the same things as their Democratic Socialist counterparts. They both preach that the "evils" of capitalism and individualism are responsible for the ills of society and that a bigger and more powerful government is needed to protect our right to live our lives as we choose.
